### "Peace and Safety" ??

The recent developments in Israel have surprised me as much as they have anyone else. I still cannot really believe that an Israeli government has chosen to deal with Arafat and the P.L.O. Nevertheless, at the time of this writing, we have just sampled the spectacle of the prime minister of a sovereign nation shaking hands with an international terrorist, and the agreement between them is fact.

To put together some thoughts on this crucial development, I have reminisced about my 20 years of touring and residing in the Holy Land, which has included more than 40 tours. I am acquainted with a number of citizens of Israel, including Palestinian Arabs, Christians and Moslems; and I have commented from biblical and journalistic perspectives on that country as a matter of ministry. Still, when assessing an event of this magnitude, everybody is an amateur. I'll say what I can from my experience and from the perspective of biblical prophecy.

First of all, I think this entire agreement comes under the heading of a false peace. Scripture is replete with ringing warnings about just such a characteristic in the end times. Familiar to all are such verses as, "Peace, peace, when there is no peace" (Jer. 6:14, 8:11); or, "For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them" (1 Thess. 5:30); or, "By peace shall he (the Antichrist) destroy many" (Dan. 8:25). This is not to say that the makers of this particular peace covenant are not well-intentioned or that somebody plans a double-cross. Men can have their own agendas, but God's plan, nevertheless, marches on.

To say that any event in world news squares with some biblical prophecy is to invite criticism and skepticism. How many times have we seen predicted raptures come and go, or "Armageddons" fall short of ending the world. So, predicting the end by some modern-world happening is hazardous; but that doesn't mean we are to be asleep when the end comes.

Scripture admonishes in 1 Thess. 5:4: "Ye, brethren, are not in darkness that the day should overtake you like a thief." With all of the above understood, let me make some predictions.

First, I think the peace will hold for a while and that the world will be somewhat reassured. However, the posture of Israel in the Tribulation Period — to be "hated of all nations" (Matt. 24:9) indicates that things will go sour in time. At the moment, the P.L.O.'s reputation has been restored, amazingly enough, and Israel, forever the victim, is being coerced to give up its territory to make peace work. The Israelis and the P.L.O. have been characterized in the press as equal and opposite enemies, both guilty of violence and terrorism. That is a ridiculous conception, however. Israel is a sovereign nation which wants only to be left alone. The P.L.O. is a terrorist organization whose entire function has been terroristic acts on an international level. We would not put up with an argument characterizing the gangs of Los Angeles and the police


department of Los Angeles as being equal antagonists in some battle. To say all of that more clearly, Israel needs to get a major black eye to play its role in the Tribulation Period when the Antichrist will descend on the Temple, and that apparently has started.

Second, we have broken through the membrane of the "land for peace" principle. Tiny Israel is doing what no nation has ever been asked to do — giving up its territory and placing its citizens in the line of fire of those who have sworn from time immemorial to destroy Israel. To assume that the leopard can change its spots and that the destruction of Israel is only a hope of the past runs counter to biblical principle. The Second Coming of the Lord happens to prevent the total destruction of the Holy Land and all the rest of the world as well. ("Except those days be shortened, there should no flesh be saved" Matt. 24:22). Now that land has been given for the small price of modest recognition on the part of bitter enemies, more will be demanded until Israel must refuse and then be regarded as intractable and unwilling to make peace.

Thirdly, we also have to regard the profound influence of the world media on this delicate situation. As if in answer to cries of the prophets, the media a decade or so ago turned anti-Israel and it has not changed since. It mindlessly favors Arab dictatorships over the only democracy in the Middle East and constantly badgers Israel as though it were some major power among the vast world of the Arabs. To repeat the figures again — it's one nation of 4 million vs. 22 nations of about 200 million. In some cases, it's 20th century vs. the 10th; modern, moral, democratic against feudal, primitive, totalitarian regimes; and still the media cannot get enough of Israel-bashing until it has made that nation some kind of pariah. The almost minuscule casualty figures of the Palestinian problem in Israel have captured world attention, while conflicts hundreds of times the size -Bosnia, South Africa, Ireland, Red China, languished etc. have inconsequential, local arguments. I predict that the media will continue blasting the Israelis, no matter what they do, and will be a major force in bringing Israel into its Tribulation Period posture. When the Antichrist is ready to come, the whole world will be saying, "Yes, those Jews deserve it!"

Fourthly, anti-Semitism is a major announcer of the oncoming Tribulation. We are seeing it in this country, all over Europe and, of course, perennially in the Middle East. And yet, the Jews are persecuted for nothing at all. Historically and in the modern world, they've really done nothing to deserve such hatred. But Bible people know the real reason behind these negative passions; when God chose the

Jews, His enemy chose them, too. The argument in the first chapter of Job — whether God's righteous ones will turn against Him if the devil curses them has been played out many times in the tragic history of the Jewish people. We are preparing at the time of this writing a television series on anti-Semitism and this new peace covenant. Those programs will be ready after our "Tell It On The Mountain" series.

I can only say that when prophetic events are already happening, nothing can be done to stop them. As I put it on a recent program, when it has started to rain, we don't try to stop the rain, but we get people into the Ark. This is the time of salvation! Some are saved out of fear, Scripture says, and indeed fear of the end was always a major human reason for the appeal of the Gospel. There's not a person on earth who does not wonder when he is going when he dies and how he will account for himself before whatever power lies over that edge. If we can make clear that God's announced, prophetic end of the age is virtually upon us, then it becomes decision time for everyone. The witness is not so much, "The bridegroom cometh," but more like, "Don't be a fool." If a person is too skeptical to come to Christ out of love, then let it be out of good old self-preservation. Or, to say it another way, if this world is truly going to hell in a hand basket, any sensible person should make a plan to evacuate.

I suppose I could write on for pages concerning this remarkable new development in the affairs of modern men, but time will show us new problems and new moves of the Lord. We probably won't be leaving this subject until the end itself is here, so I'll save some thoughts for upcoming issues of the *Levitt Letter*.

### Reality in Mideast Peace Talks

The newest round in the Middle East "peace talks" between Israel and her Arab neighbors (and Palestinian adversaries within and without Israel's borders) opened Tuesday. The objective is unchanged for too many of Israel's enemies. It is not peace but the obliteration of the Jewish state and every Jew that Islamic "holy warriors" can kill.

As in virtually every other session, world attention seems to be focused more on how much land Israel can be forced to give up to Syria, to Jordan and to a Palestian "state," and less on what Israel needs for her own security (surrounded as she is by increasingly hostile terrorist cells who want complete domination of all land occupied by Jews).

Revisiting the Covenant of the Islamic Resistance Movement is a frightening remind-

er of what Israel faces as she "negotiates" with those who bear her no good will: "Israel will exist and will continue to exist until Islam will obliterate it," begins the covenant. "The Islamic Resistance Movement is a distinguished Palestinian movement, whose allegiance to Allah, and whose way of life is Islam. It strives to raise the banner of Islam over every inch of Palestine."

Those who don't understand that Muslims see death in a righteous cause as a worthy goal seriously misjudge Islamic intenions.

This is a reminder to those inside and outside Israel that for terrorist groups like Hamas, there can be no faith in "peace talks." There is faith only in Allah, who instructs his loyal followers to make war on the Jewish "infidel" and all others who reject Islam because this is their just punishment. Those who don't understand that Muslims see death in a righteous cause as a worthy goal seriously misjudge Islamic intentions at the negotiating table. Consider the covenant's words: "The Islamic Resistance Movement aspires to the realization of Allah's promise, no matter how long that should take. The Prophet, Allah ... has said: 'The day of judgment will not come until Muslims fight and kill the Jews.'"

Given the tendency of much of the West to forget what is at stake, we should be reminded that Israel has fought five wars

(not counting the continuing one against terrorism) to maintain a small living space for world Jewry. She is a nation dwarfed by an encircling Arab population 50 times her size. Her army is outnumbered 13 to one by standing Arab armies and she faces an air force three times larger and is at an even greater disadvantage in the number of tanks.

Various "peace plans" would cede portions of land that would so reduce Israel's size that you could walk across portions of the country in less than a day. Then the enemy's modern weaponry could be employed on the shrunken Israel's new borders and attacks launched against major Israeli population centers. There is nothing

to prevent such attacks other than Israel's resolve, military power and as much of a land "buffer zone" as possible.

In a recent editorial endorsing Israeli Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin's decision to openly negotiate with Palestinians tied to the PLO, The New York Times characterized the move as "brave" and said, "It is a political and diplomatic gamble worth taking because it just might open some previously locked doors to peace."


## "... a political and diplomatic gamble worth taking"?

This presumes that the obstacle to peace is Israel and that only what Israel does or doesn't do has an impact on the "peace process" in the Middle East. In fact, the door has been locked from the Arab side, with terrorists and others whose view of peace doesn't include the existence of Israel holding the key.

There can be no peace in the Middle East until the Islamic Covenant is repealed. Of course, that is not likely to happen because it is derived from "holy writ," not subject to change by human negotiators. Israel's goal, and that of U.S. policy, should be Israel's preservation. That cannot happen with naive "negotiations" with those out to kill you, but by showing a stronger arm than your enemies. Israel has managed to survive only by maintaining a sense of moral and spiritual purpose and not trusting the motives of others who claim to be looking out for her best interests but don't live in the neighborhood.

Let the Arab side try something new — like voiding its declaration of war. Israel should only trust God, and keep her powder dry.

It not only shows the Holy Land in its truly beautiful light, but it depicts some of the very mountains being given away or remaining in contention due to the present circumstances. It's always hard to explain how television works, but the major expenses are incurred as a new series is airing. Post-production, the in-studio editing of the raw footage from location, is far and away the most expensive part of the project, and we depend on your gifts from earlier programs to pay the bills for later programs. I want to give a very strong recommendation for our Christmas tour. This year, for the first time in several years, we can show you a Holy Land that should be close to 100 percent free of tension. I expect the Arab

Bazaar of East Jerusalem to be wide open and active, with everyone putting his best foot forward. Jericho should make an interesting part of the tour, and we may be able to even view the new P.L.O. headquarters, if it is set up at that time. Presumably, they will welcome foreign guests, as the Israelis always have. Our people on the ground over there will keep us fully informed of the situation, as always, but I expect an even more friendly reception and a tour that can expand into many more areas than in the past. The Christmas tour is also quite a bargain each year - the basic tour, which includes our standard itinerary and hotels, will be \$1999. Our extended tour will include that one-of-akind experience in this lifetime Christmas Eve in Bethlehem.

Please bear in mind that we taped during our Fall tour and have brought home new footage. We covet your prayers and support, as always, for this project. I know that at the year's end, many people will give generously, as is their habit, and we certainly count on that. But for those of you who could give now, at the beginning of the last quarter, you will ease considerably the burden for us and still have a tax advantage. Naturally, all gifts to our ministry are tax-deductible, and we can put the money to work immediately for the Kingdom.

And thank you! I never forget that it is your support that makes everything happen in this ministry.

#### "WON'T IT BE NICE..."

The headlines have been chock full of *it*. The newsmagazines have devoted their cover articles to *it*. Zola broadcasted a special television program devoted to *it*. Our phones here at the ministry have been ringing off the hook. It is no surprise to any of our supporters that the seemingly impossible has occurred — the nation of Israel has signed a peace treaty with the Palestinian Liberation Organization.

This is the most intriguing event to happen in that region in a decade and a half. I will not cover the theological or political ramifi-

cations of the peace treaty at this time. Rather, I will take this opportunity to speculate

We take pilgrimages over to the Holy Land four times per year, and I have written about our experiences several times in this column. However, in just three days we are about to embark on the most significant tour we have ever undertaken. When we arrive in Israel, it will be a land taking the first tentative steps toward peace with itself. Our Fall tour group will be among the very first Americans to see the people of Israel, Jews and Palestinians, coming to terms with their internal strife. When we walk through the dusty streets of Old Jerusalem we will see new things. No, we will not yet see the wolf lying down with the lamb, as the above quote from the prophet imagines — that will take the Messiah's return. But

won't it be nice to have a foretaste of the millennial lifestyle to come, a small glimpse of the ultimate peace that Jesus will establish in His kingdom?



Won't it be nice to experience the first tiny, hesitant steps of peace in this land that throughout its history has known so little peace? How appropriate that it comes at this time, the holiest time of the Jewish year, the ten Days of Awe bridging Rosh Hashanah, the New Year, and Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement. These are the solemn

days when
Jews worldwide examine themselves,
searching
their souls
in order to

determine whether they have offended man or God throughout the past year. When the conclusion of the ten days is at hand, and Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement arrives, it is the responsibility of each Jewish person to make peace between himself and others before he makes peace between himself and the Lord. This is what the Israeli people have made a brave and honorable attempt to do. In a few days when the Day of Atonement is upon them, Israelis will approach God knowing they have done all that is in their power to bring peace, shalom, to their land.

Won't it be nice on this, the twentieth anniversary of the Yom Kippur War, to know that this year there is hope alongside the

No, certainly not; however, I do look forward to seeing the genesis of peace between these two neighbors who share Holy living space. I believe this is a clear signal that history as we know it is soon coming to a close. Unless He chooses to return by then, I invite you all to join us on the December or March tours as we see how the peace is practically lived out in the land of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.
