Letters to Zola

We have recently received a large number of candid and timely letters. As you know, Zola is unable to respond to individual inquiries as frequently as he would like, but he has chosen to share a representative sampling with you here.

The group Jews for Judaism takes its name from Jews for Jesus. They are opposed to Jews coming to the Messiah and they go to amazing lengths to try to "reconvert" Jewish people back into non-Messianic Judaism. I myself have received reams of letters purporting to wish to discuss complex doctrines of the Old Testament and so forth but really aiming to "straighten me out." There is some value to looking at the following recent article from the religion section of Columbia, S.C.'s *The State* newspaper by staff writer Jennifer Graham.

► Group Seeks to Reclaim 'Lost' Jews You've probably heard of Jews for Jesus. What about Jews for Judaism?

It's an idea whose time has come, says a leader of the group, Rabbi Tovia Singer, who recently spoke in Charleston.

Among the questions he raised: "Why have more Jews converted to Christianity in the last 19 years than in the last 1,900 years?"

As of 1990, Singer says, there were about 125,000 so-called "Hebrew Christians" or "Messianic Jews" in the United States. "Clearly," he said, "we must be doing something wrong."

The 50 million or so Americans who consider themselves born-again are obsessed with converting the nation's 5 million Jews, Singer says. Why? He gives three reasons.

- The New Testament prioritizes Jews for conversion. Quoting the gospels with the ease of a Baptist preacher, Singer recalls verses like Matthew 10:5, where Jesus says "Go nowhere among the Gentiles...but rather go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."
- right prominently into eschatology, the study of the end times. Many fundamentalists believe Jesus said he would not return until the Jews had been converted. "According to the church, the Jews are holding up the show," Singer said.
- ► Thirdly, the idea of a Messiah is exclusively Jewish, Singer said.

"If you wanted to find the job description of a Messiah, you would find it in the Jewish scriptures. So who should have known the Messiah, who should have recognized him? The Jews."

"Virtually all the world religions accept Jesus on a certain level, at least as a prophet, except Judaism, the very faith he claimed to fulfill.

This has always been a troubling reality to the church."

Keeping the faith. Jews for Judaism was founded in 1985 to counter the efforts of Christians to evangelize Jews and to counsel "Hebrew Christians" back into the fold. Singer travels throughout North America speaking to Jewish and Christian leaders about what motivates evangelicals. (The Catholic Church and most mainline denominations, he says, don't aggressively try to convert Jews.)

A failing of Jewish people, Singer said, is the education of their young. Many Jewish college graduates have the religious education of an 8-year-old. And Jews tend to be Bible illiterates, he says.

"If I see someone on a bus reading the Bible, I know it's a Christian. The Jew is reading the Wall Street Journal." he said.

"Uninformed Jews are like 'sitting ducks,' Singer said. "They have no knowledge of their own faith to defend it."

There is much truth in what the rabbi says and a certain wistful earnestness to his As to the present-day revival questions. among the Jews, this was to be expected as the end times draw near. The spiritual polarization of the whole world is obvious, and the Jews, about whom all right religious faith has always revolved, are no exception.

As to the 50 million born-again Americans being obsessed with converting the Jews, I wish I could find 50 of such zealous spiritual persuasion. The rabbi is perfectly right when he points out that the New Testament, a Jewish book by all Jewish writers published in Israel, prioritizes Jews for conversion. might also read Acts 10 and 11 when the virtually totally Jewish Church is taken by surprise when Gentiles come to the faith. He is correct in stating how important Jewish people in Israel are to the end times but, like most Jewish people, he has no real appreciation of that fact. He is like a man holding onto a stick of wood in the ocean,

pointing at people on a ship and saying, "Those idiots think I'm going to drown."

On his thought-provoking statement on the idea of a Messiah being exclusively Jewish, that was true until the Lord handed the keys of the Kingdom to Peter. There is a moment in the gospel when the directive changes from "Go nowhere among the Gentiles" to "Make disciples of all nations" ("nations" in Hebrew is "goyim" or "gentiles"), and this rabbi, who is "quoting the gospels with the ease of a Baptist preacher," ought to be able to see that. And if, indeed, the job description of a Messiah is found "in the Jewish Scriptures," why hasn't he found it? In fact, he goes on to ask, "So who should have known the Messiah, who should have recognized Him? The Jews." Right again, Rabbi.

His observation about the Catholic church and most mainline denominations not aggressively trying to convert Jews is so sadly true. seldom speak to the so-called "mainline" denominations and I have been asked only once in my quarter-century speaking career to speak to a Catholic group, and they chose to hold their meeting in a home rather than the church building.

I'm glad the rabbi pointed out that Jews tend to be Bible illiterates because that is another sad truth and is actually the fundamental reason why they don't come to the Lord. Anyone with any sort of open mind will find that Jesus is the Messiah when he reads the Bible. There is good reason that rabbis almost never use it and never quote it in Jewish services. — Zola



ISRAEL THE CENTER OF DIVINE HISTORY

Part V

AUGUSTINE AND REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY

It was Augustine around A.D. 400 who ultimately articulated the idea, principally in his well-known work, The City of God. Augustine admitted that at one time he had espoused the doctrine of "Chiliasm," the belief in a future millennium, in which the Church and redeemed Israel will be blessed by the personal return and reign of Christ on the earth. However, he had since come to the "more satisfactory" view that the Church has replaced Israel forever. Jerusalem and the Temple were destroyed in fulfillment of prophecy, and the Jews were dispersed throughout the Roman empire. Judaism was branded in the New Testament as an imperfect religion that has been superseded by the Gospel of Christianity. Rome was in its ascendancy as the center of Christian thought and worship.

Rather than looking to some political renewal on this present earth, Augustine taught that we should look to the New Jerusalem, the eternal city of God. In effect, he "leapfrogged" over the Millennium as a future event and saw

the Millennial promises fulfilled in the Church age. He further envisioned the Second Coming of Christ as not ushering in the Millennium, but the Eternal State of the New Heaven, the New Earth, and the New Jerusalem.

Christendom canonized Augustine as an official saint, and theologians throughout the Roman Empire accepted his doctrines. The

Chiliasts were branded as holding aberrant views, if not heresy, and Augustinian Replacement Theology became the cornerstone of Roman Catholic concepts. In the later developments in the Eastern Orthodox Church, the European Reformation and the Anglican split, Replacement Theology continued essentially untouched. It was an important part of the standard Christian view of Israel, the world, and prophecy.

The effect of all this on Christian attitudes about Israel was devastating. In actuality, Replacement Theology disenfranchised Israel from having a continuing covenant relationship with God. Instead of looking at Jerusalem as the "City of the Great King," in which Christ will reign for a thousand years upon His return, they saw Jerusalem's perpetual desolation as much as a confirmation of Christianity as the destruction of Pharaoh's army in the Red Sea was a confirmation of Moses.

DOMINANCE OF REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY IN CHURCH HISTORY

This anti-Israel view continued as dominant in Christianity until the rise of Premillennial/Dispensationalism (along with Zionism) in the 19th Century. Replacement Theology is still the majority view among professing Christian theologians, but Premillennialism is by and large considered a legitimate and vocal minority, at least in evangelical Protestant circles.

Thus, in relation to the rise of Zionism and Modern Israel, Christianity has brought a divided message. Some (the Premillennial/Dispensationalists) have applauded the rise of the new State of Israel as evidence of the near fulfillment of the Second

A NOTE FROM ZOLA



Dear Friends.

Typically I give you an up-to-date report on Israel after each of our tours. But this time I instead want to share an amusing and perhaps useful article which appeared on the front page of the *Jerusalem Post* in the issue before the Day of Atonement, a day of fasting. For those of you who fast periodically, the following advice may be helpful.

Tips to Keep You Well Over the Fast

Prof. Elliot Berry, head of clinical nutrition at the Hebrew University - Hadassah School of Medicine, offers the following tips for this Yom Kippur:

- The pre-fast meal today should include some salt because the intense heat is likely to deplete the body's sodium supplies through perspiration.
- If possible, pray in an airconditioned synagogue.
- Don't walk in the heat -"and that includes a trek in 38° (= 100°F) weather to the Western Wall."
- The best way to avoid hunger and thirst during a fast is to eat and drink frequently but gradually during the day before Yom Kippur.
- An ideal meal consists of non-spicy dishes of complex carbohydrates pasta, potatoes, corn, beans, rice and whole grain bread, with several glasses of water or juice.

- The "anti-fast drops" being sold around the country — "these have absolutely no known beneficial effect."
- People with chronic diseases, such as diabetes or a heart condition, should consult a doctor and/or rabbi before deciding whether to fast.
- Break the fast gradually, beginning with juice, followed by a light snack. Only an hour or so later should one sit down to a full meal.

My own suggestion would be to make your peace with God and come to the Messiah so that your atonement will already be made and you won't have to fast at all, at least to atone for your sins.

Better yet, come with us and see the Land of the Lord and His always most interesting brethren on December 12th.

What is remarkable, when I read Scripture as it is written, is why so few Jewish people have come to the One who fulfilled so many Jewish prophecies of Messiah's coming.

Dear Zola,

I didn't get a chance to see the movie Schindler's List, but I've just finished reading the book. If a bedroom scene offends some, then I recommend the book, which treats that aspect of Schindler superficially. Unless the reader has a heart of pure stone, he or she will be emotionally stressed by this book — I was.

The Holocaust must be remembered by all of us. We must also realize that the hundred odd souls imprisoned for days in two frozen rail cars and left to die, as well as Helen Hirsch and Genia, the child in red (and countless others), were victims of a satanic morality, not just a political system. The things shaping up today appear to be taking the same form, so I don't think you're a bit off base when you remind Gentiles (such as me) about them. I suspect that the trend, if it continues unchecked, will probably lead to ovens fueled with both Christians and Jews.

It was what happened to the young Horowitz boy that really stabbed me through the heart. If he is still alive, he must be about my age — a little younger in fact. At a time when the kids in my neighborhood were drinking Kool-Aid and eating peanut butter and cracker sandwiches on a midsummer after-

noon, playing and generally doing the things you expect children to do, young Horowitz was being caused to lose his rightful childhood innocence, to witness murders and be subjected to unspeakable terrors, but not to really understand why. I've never thought of a playground swing in terms of a hanging scaffold, but I will from here on.

As for Schindler, he certainly had a flair for women, but he also had an uncommon courage for applying the principle Jesus of Nazareth taught in Matthew 25, "...to the least of these, my brethren...".

Is it possible for a Gentile/Christian to be a Zionist?

Dearest Zola & Staff:



Coming of Christ. However, many representatives of official Christianity (the Replacement Theologians) are either neutral or antagonistic.

CHRISTIANITY BOTH PRO- AND ANTI-ISRAEL

Such organizations as the Roman Catholic Church and the World Council of Churches have, for the last half century, taken positions favoring the Arab and Moslem enemies of Israel. They have defended this bias partly by claiming representation in the various countries involved. But a vital part of this bias

is based on the theological convictions that cannot abide the resurrection of Israel from the ashes of the Dispersion.

It is with considerable reluctance that the Vatican has recognized Israel, and the Church's primary interest is in asserting its influence in maintaining its Holy Places in Jerusalem. Similarly, the World Council of Churches has consistently pled the cause of Palestinians against the claims of Israel.


Thus, Christianity has, because of its differing theological views about the future of Israel, had a divided attitude about Zionism and the revived State of Israel. Part of Christianity has expressed delight with the modern Israel, while part has been very negative toward Israel's very existence. (To be continued)



THE HOUSE OF DAVID STONE REPLICA



Found July 21, 1993 in northern Israel, this ninth-century B.C. inscription bears the first reference to King David ever found outside the Bible. Reading from right to left in Aramaic, the phrase is pronounced, "Bate Da-veed." This term refers to a dynasty or an unending kingship.

A friend of the ministry referred me to the following remarks by a very good pastor, John Wesley. We were both amazed that the references to the decaying society that is the subject of this sermon is England of 1760 and not our own land in 1994.

See how our own country mourns and suffers under the outpourings and overflowings of ungodliness! What crimes of every kind are committed each day, too often with impunity. Many sin with a high-handedness and glory in their shame! They brag about their acts. Who can count up all the oaths, curses, profanities, blasphemies; all Sabbath-breaking, the gluttony, drunkenness, revenge: the fornications, adulteries. and various uncleannesses; the frauds, injustice. oppression, and extortion which cover over our land as a flood of evil?

And even those who have kept themselves away from these grosser acts are not innocent. How much anger, pride, sloth, idleness, softness, effeminacy, self-indulgence, covetousness, ambition, thirst of praise, love of the world, and fear of man is to be found among us?

How little true religion is there! Where is he who loves either God or his neighbor as Jesus has commanded?

On the one hand, there are those who have not so much as the form of godliness. On the other hand, there are those who have the form only. One is the open sepulcher, the other is the painted sepulcher. In any public gathering, including our own churches, one part is Sadducees and the other Pharisees. One part has almost as little concern about religion as if there were no resurrection. The other part makes religion a mere lifeless form, a dull round of external performances, without true faith, the love of God, or joy in the Holy Spirit.

I wish to God that I could exclude all of us from this charge. My heart's desire and prayer for you is that you may be saved from this overflowing of ungodliness, and excluded from this group. But are you excluded? God knows, and our own consciences know otherwise. You have not kept yourselves pure. You are also corrupt and abominable. There are but few who understand God and worship Him in spirit and truth.

We are a generation that has not set our hearts right. Our spirits do not cling steadfastly unto God. He has called and appointed us to be the salt of the earth. "But if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trodden under foot by men."

"Shall I not visit you for these things?" says the Lord. "Shall not my soul be avenged on such a nation as this?" We do not know how soon He may say to the sword, "Sword, go through this land." He has given us a long time to repent. He lets us alone this year also. But He warns and awakens us by thunder. His judgments are abroad in this world. He judges all of us. We have all the reason to expect the worst. He could come quickly and remove us from our special place unless we repent and do the first works, and return to the principles of the living faith, truth, and simplicity of the gospel.

Perhaps we are now resisting the last effort of divine grace to save us. Perhaps we have almost filled up the cup with our iniquities, by rejecting the counsel of God against ourselves, and casting out His messengers.

It is high time for us to awake out of spiritual sleep before the great trumpet of the Lord is blown, and our land becomes a field of blood.


