Thanks for a wonderful year! Together we did some mighty works in 1994!

Because of year-end giving, many charitable organizations begin

each January with a nest egg that erodes as loyal supporters contend with credit card bills from Christmas and then summer vacation expenses. A ministry's downward sloping asset line can make financial charts look gloomy. In our case, the December '93 funds that weren't put to immediate use helped to cover airtime and new TV

production in the spring, summer and fall of '94. We are convinced that yearend gifts are to be

mobilized — not accumulated. And what a year we've had!

After producing the six-program *Holocaust* television series, we were able, thanks to you, to commit to and produce the entire 17-program *House of David* TV series. In addition, our new *Faith in the Fire* album may be the finest collection of contemporary Christian music available anywhere. We used the wonderful Messianic singer Marty Goetz and the arranger from the Lamb music group.

Our new eight-audiocassette collection Discovering Our Jewish Roots is a magnificent survey of both Testaments that fully reveals the undeniable bond of Christianity and Judaism. Our *House of David* stone, a handsome, mounted replica of the ninth-century B.C. inscription, bears the first reference to King David ever found outside the Bible. And last, but not least, thanks to much prayer, medication and two angioplasties, my father, Zola, hosted four more Israel tours.

Have you heard that old adage equating watered-down ministry with a vaccination? Many "patients" get just enough religion to be immunized <u>against</u> it. But if Bible teaching on location from Israel doesn't give our viewership the real "disease," then it certainly encourages

helpful bacteria. Throughout the year, your prayer and support have enabled us to reach millions

with much more than an inoculation against Christ.

Sometimes I wonder how we are able to accomplish so much with so little. With a staff of twelve, we broadcast a weekly national TV program, publish two monthly newsletters for about 30,000 readers, process 7,000 pieces of



mail per month and ship almost 70,000 Bible teaching items per year. God is definitely with us!

Last year when I figuratively compared our ministry to the *Star Trek Enterprise*, one of you kindly sent me the enclosed picture of Scottie. When this biblical rocket has concluded its mission, we will have left a mighty multidecade trail of Bible teaching in hearts and personal libraries across America.

I thank God not only for this heaven-sent enterprise but also for our blessed

messenger Zola and our gifted TV producer Ken Berg. We've also been privileged to forward your donations designated to sister ministries, needy Israelis and worthwhile causes we've publicized.

This ministry owns no real estate. We've never appealed for funds for a production studio or a TV camera. Our "Ministry Limo" is an '84 station wagon. Outside vendors do our printing, bulk mailing and tape duplication. We've locked our sights on God's will: Jewish-Christian teaching on TV and through the mail. There's no room (or need) for empire-building here.

A sister ministry recently asked our air time buyer how we survive with so little fund raising. In our case, I believe part of God's will boils down to running "lean and mean." It costs money to raise funds, and not doing too much of that is one way we economize.

Thanks to you, we're proclaiming nationwide, "Look, these biblical events really happened, and here's where they happened. And here's what the Bible has to say about what's happening right now!" We don't avoid the sensitive issues, and while our mailing list diminishes from time to time, our revenues remain stable. It's still true that only about 3% of our viewers have ever donated to us. Hopefully that other 97% is contributing somewhere.

We have probably lost some supporters who wanted to quit hearing about Israel and "get back to the Bible." It is unfortunate, but with many Christians, Israel just isn't an issue. That's only one among many categories of need for our outreach. The excellent articles you've seen by theologian Dr. Thomas McCall have been an assurance that each *Levitt Letter* carries at least one meaty Bible lesson for the dedicated student.

The fact is that a lot of Zola's Bible knowledge originated from Bible studies with Tom. You may have noticed that Zola and Tom have coauthored about seven books. There's a funny story in that regard. At a reception, a publisher was overheard explaining that McCall was the thinker and Levitt the writer. The response: "Oh, so you're telling me that McCall can't write and Levitt can't think."

Once we heard from a lawyer in Texas who "suspected" he had contributed in the past. Enclosing no gift, he was responding to an inquiry of whether he still wanted our newsletters after nearly a year and a half of no responses. He commented that he loved our TV programs and newsletters and anticipated that he might help us someday. Pray for him.

Our teaching goes free to the unhelpful wealthy as well as the destitute. . . . Who else does what we do?

ISRAEL THE CENTER OF DIVINE HISTORY

Part VII

COMMON COMMITMENT TO THE FUTURE OF ISRAEL

Now back to Balfour and Weizmann. It was not just high-powered explosives and the Allied victory that drew them together, there was also a common belief in the future of Israel. Weizmann was an ardent Zionist, and was in constant communication with the Zionist leaders, such as Theodore Herzl, in England and Europe. He was eager to further Jewish settlement in Palestine, which had already begun by the turn of the century as Jews escaped from the persecutions in Russia and Eastern Europe. They found refuge in the agricultural kibbutzim around Galilee.

Balfour, on the other hand (as we noted before), was a devout Christian, and had been exposed to the premillennial and dispensational teaching that had been rediscovered in

the Scriptures during the previous century. He believed that the Jews must return to the Land as part of the preparation for the

Second Coming of Christ, and was thrilled to think that he could have a part in it. Although Balfour accomplished many significant achievements in the British government, it is reported that, in his final days, he felt the most important thing he had accomplished in his life was the Declaration encouraging the resettlement of the Jewish people in their homeland.

PALESTINE AS A BRITISH MANDATE

Prior to WW I, Palestine had been ruled by Turkey for many years. During the war, Turkey was aligned with Germany, so Britain attacked Turkey from Egypt through Palestine. It was a dramatic time when the British General Allenby captured Jerusalem from the Turks. As the war concluded, Palestine was designated as a British protectorate. Thus, England had to decide how it was to administer the protectorate, and the Balfour Declaration promising a homeland to the Jewish people in Palestine was the apparent solution to the problem.

THE CONTRADICTORY PRO-JEWISH & PRO-ARAB BRITISH POLICIES

A very serious problem, however, was that not only was there a pro-Jewish faction in England led by Foreign Minister Balfour, there was also a pro-Arab faction heavily influenced by "Lawrence of Arabia," which was making contrary covert promises to the Arabs. This duplicity in the British government led to much confusion and ultimately bloodshed in later years. Nevertheless, the impact of the

Balfour Declaration on the restoration of the Jewish people to the Land cannot be overestimated. It was brought about, in no

small measure, by the convergence of Jewish Zionism and British Christian Dispensationalism in the persons of Weizmann and Balfour.

THE CONTRIBUTION OF AMERICAN DISPENSATIONALISM

American Christian Dispensationalism also appeared to be involved, to a lesser extent, at the time. The Balfour Declaration was not just drafted in one day by the Foreign Minister. It was carefully crafted with many revisions over a period of several weeks. It went back and forth between the British Cabinet and various Jewish groups. Some

A NOTE FROM ZOLA



Dear Friends,

Israel is rapidly becoming what Scripture says it will be in the End Times — the center of the earth. The media remain polarized on the question of the peace process and what side they will take in the ongoing conflict (typically 90% favor the Arabs, for some reason known only to God and His enemy). It places a heavy responsibility on our ministry to continue to televise the real story about Israel and to battle the terrific array of anti-Semitic forces around us today. Truly, Israel is inexorably being forced into its End Times posture — "...hated of all nations," in the words of our Lord (Matt. 24:9).

During the spring of the past year, we covered the developing "peace" situation as thoroughly as possible for us, but we were already filming our lengthy *House of David* series. We did manage to get interviews with ex-prime minister Yitzhak Shamir and Israeli Parliament opposition leader Benjamin Netanyahu on our June tour. These we televised during the summer and will feature again at the end of the year. Stay tuned.

We also were able to obtain a precious hour with Cal Thomas, the noted TV commentator and talk-show host, who is an outspoken believer in Israel and its rightful King. We will run that footage also on a year-end program, along with a rerun of former U.N. Representative Jeane Kirkpatrick's marvelous testimony about the Holy Land.

Obviously we look ahead to an exciting year, continuing to chronicle the situation in the Promised Land. During 1994 we saw Arafat exposed for what he is, and we had predicted all of this. More Israelis died this

year under the peace process than in any year of the previous Arab uprising, and we predicted that, too. As I said in this column last December, "Deception is the key to the End Times; the Antichrist will depend on it for his power over world governments. Conceivably Arafat, 30 years a professional terrorist, will appear to change his spots and deceive Israel into providing him a base of operations within the Promised Land."

Obviously all of the above has happened, and the base of operations is Gaza. Arafat postures at trying to round up "the terrorists," but this is only for naive media consumption. As the cartoon character Pogo observed of Americans, "We have met the enemy and he is us."

The responsibility we have to cover the almost uncovered side of the story about Israel is overwhelming. Our budget is short, and we never set out to do a tough job like that. Our source materials are 10,000 miles from home, and everything we say is contradicted by much broader based television and news services. But I'll tell you this, we are very willing to stay on the front lines, even though there are heavier guns, and hold our position.

But you are the "quartermaster corps." You send us our ammunition and our supplies. If we continue the quality of coverage of current events that we did during 1994, we need your increasing support. Obviously we have increased expenses.

Now I want to point out that it is a very Christian thing to do to support this contemporary kind of program. It gathers an audience of unbelieving viewers, unsaved Jews in particular, and it helps to inform a misled public. Jesus Christ said, "Everyone that is of the truth hears my voice" (John 18:37). Believing people should help to get the truth out, especially the truth about Israel. Mark's article in the front of our letter will make you aware of our real numbers and our business stability. You are backing a "winner," although we don't win anything as

a nonprofit organization. I only am sad that so few of you truly support us and so many sit back and soak up the labor without paying for it.

As I pointed out last year, Paul exhorted the Church to partake in a ministry in order to share its blessings, but remonstrated with those who enjoyed the blessings but did not support the ministry. Romans 15:25-27 is relevant: the passage points out that, if you have received spiritual blessings from Israel, then you ought materially to support that source of blessings. If our teachings and our pictures from the Holy Land have improved your spiritual life and your knowledge of current things, then please at least help us of bringing defray the costs these improvements to your life.

Or more simply, as Paul put it in Romans 10:15, "How shall they preach except they be sent?"

I am sorry to say that we have had to drop a few small stations this year, although we have picked up a few others. We continually announce on the air that we cannot stay on stations which do not support us since it just wouldn't be fair to our larger audience, and yet people are invariably surprised to see us actually go off. Obviously, I am telling this message to exactly the wrong people since, if you receive this letter, you are among those who have written to us and most likely support us. Perhaps you could spread the word among friends of yours who you know watch our program because we simply need the help. Scripture tells us to make our needs known, and this is certainly one of our needs.

Surely a ministry that returns its gifts immediately in visible product that can be verified in your living room is one that can be trusted to do a good job with money. We have done that for 16 years and Mark's report attests to our good fiscal condition. And as I said last year, and it makes even more sense this year, if the End Times are as close as they

now seem to be, this is no time to economize on Godly works. We will witness to the Jews for you. We'll go to Israel and spread the Word for you. We'll speak to a million Gentiles on television for you every week, if you will simply send us your prayers and the financial support necessary to do this ministry.

Thank you very much for all of your kindness. We know that this is your ministry and we are grateful to you.

God is not broke. His plans will succeed, of course, regardless of who chooses to become a part of them. One question for those considering helping our ministry in particular is, who else does what we do? What could replace the on-location Bible teaching and the music of *Zola Levitt Presents*?

After 16 years of TV production, we've accumulated such an extensive library of Israel footage that we've become a prime source for sister ministries, including one who is using many hours of it in the creation of a multimedia version of the Bible. More on that later.

Do you know we've never had a telethon or a formal fund-raising strategy? Our approach has been to do as little fund-raising as possible. The closest we've come to having an estate planning department is occasionally mentioning an outside consultant who can help you include us in your estate plan without costing your heirs anything. His name is Wes Putnam, and his telephone number is (214) 691-5015.

This article is a straightforward fund appeal. We're good stewards doing vital work for a needy public that has very few sources for what we provide. Our audited financial reports are available for the asking. Fortunately, you don't have to take our word for what we're doing because you see our TV programs and newsletters firsthand. As before, we spend almost 70% of our revenues on TV air time and production, less than 12% on our staff, about 10% on postage and roughly 5% on printing.

recognition of a Jewish homeland in Palestine might negatively affect their status as citizens in England and other countries. When they had the wording they considered acceptable, it was sent to President Woodrow Wilson for approval. He was the son of a Presbyterian minister, had been president of Princeton University, and it might be assumed that he been exposed to the Christian Dispensational teaching that was moving across America. At any rate, President Wilson readily agreed to the proposal, and indicated to the British government that it met with the approval of the American government.


THE HAND OF GOD BEHIND THE SCENES

Thus, at the close of WW I, it appears that a minority of dispensational Christians influenced the British government, and to a lesser extent, the American government, to accelerate the restoration of Israel during the 20th century in cooperation with the Zionist cause. In ancient times God used political events in the transition of power from Babylon to Persia in the time of Daniel to restore Israel to the Land. Biblical prophecies state that Israel must return to the Land in the last days. Can it be that He used similar political events at the end of WW I to further the present restoration? At any rate, the Balfour Declaration set in motion an exponential increase from a small trickle to a veritable stream as Jewish people began their serious to the Promised Land. return Dispensationalists believe that this was the beginning of the fulfillment of biblical prophecies, and this meant that the time for the judgment of Satan and the establishment of Christ's kingdom on earth was coming ever closer. It soon became clear that Satan and his willing accomplices were not going to stand by and watch the restoration of Israel and the ultimate Second Coming of Christ to occur without determined opposition.


