With the Palestinians unable to carry out a single suicide bombing in Israel since March, and Hamas halted from unleashing the large-scale revenge attacks called for after its top terrorist leaders were assassinated, Middle East analysts and politicians are beginning to debate whether the intifada — the terrorist war against Israel started by PLO leader Yasser Arafat after rejecting offers at the Camp David peace summit in 2000 — is coming to an end.

At this time last year, there were 20 suicide bombings killing 141, while 2002 saw 25 such attacks in which 147 Israelis were killed. So far this year, there have been only two bombings in Israel proper, killing 19. The security fence completed in Gaza and

the one being constructed in the West Bank are credited with keeping suicide bombers out, and raids in Palestinian areas and targeted killings of top terrorist commanders seem to be putting Hamas, Islamic Jihad and the Al-Aqsa Martyrs' Brigade on the run and unable to orchestrate attacks. Also, the downfall of Saddam Hussein, who was paying \$25,000 to the families of suicide bombers, is likely a contributing factor to the decline of the violence, as there is now one less incentive to the Palestinian population to join with terrorist groups.

The question is whether the trend marks the end of the intifada, or is merely a lull while the terrorists, temporarily decapitated, regroup and rethink.

"There is no doubt that efforts by the PLO to dictate the terms of our surrender and bring about our collapse have failed, they have accomplished none of their goals," chief Sharon spokesman Raanan Gissin told WND. "Therefore, one can say the intifada has failed, and is now even turning against its own initiators." Gissin points out that while Israel "always has and will continue to live with the threat of terrorism," the Jewish state turned the tables on the jihadists with its forceful antiterror campaign, and he says the violence will continue to decline.

Gissin says the Palestinian terror apparatus has been hit badly, Arafat has been internationally isolated, and the Palestinian economy has nearly crumbled as a result of the PLO's strategic decision to launch a terrorist offensive against the Jewish state instead of peaceful negotiations. Ironically, explains Gissin, the intent of the intifada was to demoralize Israel, destroy its economy, bring it to its knees, and force it to surrender to Palestinian demands. Gissin says if this was a real war, it has ended with an Israeli victory, albeit a bloody one.

Daniel Pipes, director of the Middle East Forum, concurs. "While the timetable of Palestinian recognition of failure has been slower than I expected, short of a mega-terror attack, things do seem to be winding down," he said.

Sources close to Hamas, which is responsible for many of the suicide attacks, say that in the West Bank, where most terror operations originated, the organization has been very badly damaged.

"There is no money to finance operations," said one. "Many of the leaders are gone and it is difficult to replace them. Hamas needs at least two years to rebuild." "The Palestinians have been growing increasingly weary and disgusted with their leadership," Malcolm Hoenline, executive vice-chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, told WND. "They see they gained nothing while the leaders steal their money and ruin the economy. It may be too early to say the intifada is over. The terror will continue, but with much less success."

The Jewish State is going to great lengths to separate from the Palestinians and keep its borders safe from terrorists. Israel is also putting to use a centuries-old tactic — an 80-footdeep moat, possibly to be filled with water, between Egypt and Gaza as a way to keep terrorists from crossing and block them from constructing more arms-smuggling tunnels.

Gissin says Israel will continue to drive home to the Palestinians that "whatever violence they use against us will bring them nothing but destruction. Eventually, it has to sink in with them."

Reports say most Palestinians are beginning to realize the intifada is coming to an end.



The Holy Days of Our Lord

On location in Israel, we created this presentation of the holidays our Lord celebrated. Given to Moses on Mt. V713 Overview - Zola teaches from the Mount of Olives, giving us a summary of the festivals that the Lord established for the Chosen People in Leviticus 23. Zola interviews Dan Hendrickson who explains how rabbinical Jews view each of the feasts.



V714 Passover - In front of a blood-stained doorway, Zola gives us a look at the original Exodus and our own deliverance from the wilderness of a sinful life. Each element of the traditional Seder is explained as it relates to Christ's fulfillment and the Lord's redemptive plan and picture.

V715 Unleavened Bread - Zola speaks on the Lord's festival to annually remind the Chosen People that they did not have time to let the bread rise when He delivered them out of Egypt, and how the Messiah is represented in the matzo. We go to a factory outside Jerusalem to find out how matzo is made.

V716 First Fruits - The Church and the Chosen are represented in the wave offerings of the two loaves of bread before the Lord, the offering for the new harvest season. We interview the editor of *Eretz* magazine regarding his insights into the ancient commonalties between modern Judaism and the present-day Church.

V717 Pentecost - Zola explains that when Christ told His disciples to wait until the power of the Lord came, the Jews were anticipating the celebration of Shavuot.

V718 Trumpets - Zola teaches on Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New Year, as a day of celebration and merriment. It is also a time that the seriousness of sin begins to weigh on the hearts of the Jewish people. We see how the ceremonial horns (shofars) are made. Tim LaHaye gives us his insights as to what will happen at the sound of the last trumpet.

V719 Day of Atonement - From the Mount of Olives, Zola tells us about Yom Kippur. Once a year, the priest entered into the presence of God in the Holy of Holies. Here, a sacrifice was made for the corporate sin of the nation. We show you a recreation of the Tabernacle (booth) located in Timna Park.

V720 Tabernacles - Standing next to a *sukkah* (booth), Zola explains how the mood in Israel changes from a solemn occasion of judgment to one of celebration and merriment. Chuck King tells us about the

International Christian Embassy Jerusalem plans for its yearly celebration at Qumran.

V721 Purim/Hanukkah - From the giant Menorah by the Israeli Parliament, Zola recalls the book of Esther as well as the New Testament references to the Festival of Lights, rededicating the Temple. We hear the testimony of a natural-born Israeli whose life dramatically changed when he found his Messiah.


V722 Sabbath - Standing by a stream in the desert, Zola reads from Exodus and teaches about the day of rest. He draws a contrast between this commandment and where Christian people find their "rest." Rabbi Henri Noach explains why this one day most distinguishes the Jewish people.

V723 Music - Features all the music heard in the other ten programs. We see dramatic recreations of each feast, Zola's performance on location in Israel, as well as a view of the scenic beauty of the Holy Land.

Israeli Public Swings Right

A new popular survey carried out by Haifa University's National Security Research Center indicates some surprises in public opinion on issues such as withdrawals and uprooting Jewish towns. The poll shows that nearly half of the Jewish public — 47.7% — opposes the establishment of a Palestinian state, even in the framework of a peace agreement.

In what is possibly the most surprising finding of all, Dr. Daphna Kanati-Nissim, one of those who directed the survey, told Arutz-7 that if national elections were held today, close to 30% of the public would support a Kach-like [violently anti-Palestinian] party.

In contrast with other surveys, the poll in question shows that 44% object to even a partial withdrawal from Judea, Samaria and Gaza, and 40% are against the dismantling of even one Jewish settlement. Over 55% of the Jewish public feels that Israeli-Arabs are a threat to national security. A website dedicated to Islamic law features a video presentation [see below] of four children acting out a beheading in a similar manner to recent slayings in Iraq and Saudi Arabia.

In a scene that appears to mimic the murder of Nicholas Berg, a young boy is shown kneeling in front of two boys and a girl who are masked and clothed in the style of the American's Muslim kidnappers.

The center child takes the role of Berg's alleged killer, Jordanian terrorist Abu Musaab al-Zarqawi, appearing to read a list of demands.

The footage culminates with the mock beheading of the child hostage.



Kill and Laugh

Omar Bakri Muhammad is a suspected al-Qaeda terrorist who was interviewed recently in a Portuguese newspaper, *Publico*. Here is what he had to say about the intentional killing of civilians:

"We don't make a distinction between civilians and non-civilians, innocents and non-innocents. Only between Muslims and non-believers. The life of a nonbeliever has no value. There's no sanctity in it. Terror is the language of the 21st century. If I want something, I terrorize you to achieve it.

"The word 'terrorism' is not new among Muslims. Muhammad said: 'I am the prophet who laughs when killing the enemy.' It is not only a question of killing. It's laughing while we are killing."

sure sign of the End Times coming on is that men will call good evil and evil good.

In this *Levitt Letter* we are running a story about a lawsuit filed against Fox News Channel for using the slogan "Fair and Balanced." The plaintiffs say that Fox is a mouthpiece for George Bush and the Republican party and that "Fair and Balanced" is misleading. The authors of this lawsuit know, of course, that there is no case against Fox News. They simply want the story publicized to create doubt about Fox. The more times the story (a lie) is repeated, the more doubt is created about Fox.

I personally prefer Fox News because of its balance. CNN, CBS, ABC, NBC, MSNBC, and NPR are all slanted to the left. They are anti-Israel and cannot find enough time in the day to illustrate Palestinian troubles while hardly mentioning the heroic and dangerous mission of the Israeli army—stopping Palestinian terrorism against innocent civilians.

President Bush, despite all you have heard from the media, is not evil. He is fighting against evil. The President went so far as to name some of our enemies (Irag, Iran and North Korea) "The Axis of Evil." Yet the "hate America" crowd condemned him roundly for this statement, much like Ronald Reagan was criticized for calling the Soviets the "Evil Empire." According to the "media elite," dictatorships that starve, torture, and murder their citizens by the millions are good. Evil nations that acquire nuclear weapons and then blackmail the world with them are also good. Countries like the US and Britain that forcefully free the citizens of these nations, and attempt to build democracies, are evil.

The Presbyterian "Church" USA has called the Palestinian Arabs good and the Israelis evil. As we report in this letter, the Presbyterians, at

their annual general assembly this summer, voted 431-62 in favor of joining the divestment campaign against Israel. They are the first Christian denomination to do so. Leaders of this liberal mainline church also approved several other anti-Israel resolutions at their gathering in Richmond, Virginia.

The message of this church is evil, but they piously consider themselves to be good.

Muslims are fighting a worldwide war against democracy and freedom (particularly freedom of religion), which they call evil. And what do these people call good? Dictatorships where "infidels" can be murdered for not converting to Islam. Countries where girls can be stoned to death for holding hands with a boy. Take a good look at Saudi Arabia, Iran and Syria. Those evil systems are what the Muslims want the entire world to become. Despite this. American liberals and liberal churches lend help to Muslims every day, as though they are just another religious denomination worshipping the same God.

The United Nations seems to exist to call Israel evil. Since 1945, the UN has passed over 700 General Assembly resolutions. Of these 700, not one was passed against any Arab country or against any terrorist group. How many do you think have been passed against Israel? Nearly 450! Yes, with 190 countries represented in the UN, Israel—a single nation, only slightly

Anything you could forward to me would be great!



However, your publication exudes so much hatred. We need to pray for our enemies as Jesus taught us to do. "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."


True, the Palestinians know what they are doing, but for our own sake, as well as for theirs, we need to be in continual prayer for a change in their hearts and minds. God is not dead!

They are sliding down a slippery slope toward Replacement Theology.

In newspapers, magazines, films, and on television, Christians nowadays are ridiculed, portrayed as ignorant cultists and called evil. The entertainment industry despises Christians. On July 15, 2004, the San Diego Union Tribune quoted singer Linda Ronstadt: "It's a real conflict for me when I go to a concert and find out somebody in the audience is a Republican or fundamental Christian. It can cloud my enjoyment. I'd rather not know." A few years back, Washington Post reporter Michael Weisskopf, in a now-famous quote, referred to evangelical Christians as "poor, uneducated and easy to command." To these people, Christians are not only evil, but dumb, too. But we will see who commands whom when the King returns.

It is not a matter of opinion to say that the haters of Jews, Christians and righteousness are not only wrong, but evil. Good and evil are very clearly delineated, not just in Scripture, but in every human heart. "Too Many Christians"

A Christian student club is suing Penn State University for rejecting it as a student organization after being told the school already has "too many" Christian clubs.

The university recognizes more than 600 different clubs, ranging from the American Helicopter Society to the Young Americans for Freedom, says the Christian Legal Society's Center for Law & Religious Freedom, which filed the lawsuit.

But when DiscipleMakers Christian Fellowship applied for registered status in April 2004, a university official charged with reviewing religious student organizations refused to approve the group because there were "too many [Christian] groups anyway and they were beginning to compete."

Unlike secular school clubs, Penn State requires religious student organizations to undergo a separate review process, the Christian Legal Society says.

A university administrator, the director of the center for

ethics and religious affairs, must decide whether or not the club is sufficiently "unique" from existing religious student clubs to warrant registration. DiscipleMakers tried to show how it differed from other student organizations, but Penn State officials insisted the group did not meet the university's "uniqueness requirement."

Denial of registered status means the group does not have access to meeting rooms, bulletin boards and student organization funding. DiscipleMakers also is represented by Pittsburgh attorney Lawrence Paladin and the Arizona-based Alliance Defense Fund.

The lawyers want the court to rule that Penn State is violating the First and Fourteenth Amendment rights of free speech, due process, free association, and free exercise of religion.

Ironically, Pennsylvania was founded by William Penn, a Quaker, who wanted his state to be a Christian utopia. Although Penn and his wife's "Holy Experiment" of the early 18th century didn't totally succeed, the Quakers dominated Pennsylvania for 70 years, and many still reside in the state.

In Jewish thinking, *mitzvot* (commandments) are not burdensome things, but rather opportunities to express gratitude to God for the gift of life. *Mitzvot* are compared to "garments" or "angels" that accompany a person in their journey through life. The one who keeps or observes (*shomer*) the commandment of the LORD guards his own life, for the keeping of the commandment aligns the soul (*nephesh*) with life. "Shomer mitzvah, shomer nafsho."

On the other hand, the one who despises his own ways (derekh) will die. The word translated "despises" comes from *bazah*, a verb that means to accord little worth to something. The one who is heedless of his ways or otherwise unconcerned about the high calling of obedience aligns the soul with error, and the end there-of is death (Proverbs 14:12).

In short, we are duty-bound to care about our lives. Being *shomer mitzvah* is thus a form of wakefulness, where we consciously attend to our actions in light of God's expressed will. Since every moment of our lives provides an opportunity for decision, we may always ask whether we are keeping or despising the way of life.

Christians weren't the only ones waving signs.

According to the Los Angeles Daily News, some of the signs read "Jews for the L.A. County Seal," "Buddhists for the Seal," and "Stop the ACLU Nazis."

"If people want to keep the cross, they need to remove the Democrats," said the Campaign for California Families, a conservative group that mobilized support for keeping the cross in the county seal.

CCF noted that all three people voting to remove the cross were Democrats. The two who voted to keep the cross were Republicans.

In two-and-a-half hours of public testimony, virtually all the speakers favored keeping the cross, CCF said.

"Those who don't respect the Constitution are doing everything in their power to remove Christian values in society," said Randy Thomasson, CCF executive director. "When our founding fathers wrote, 'Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion,' they didn't mean to yank crosses off public property."

Thomasson argues that the First Amendment prohibits Congress from creating an official state denomination, such as the Church of England in Great Britain.

Thomasson called Tuesday's vote a demonstration of "anti-Christian arrogance" in Los Angeles.

"Given that Democrats are the only ones attacking the cross, it's obvious that if people want to keep the cross, they need to remove the Democrats," he said.

Dying to Kill The Jerusalem Post

Iran has registered at least 10,000 young volunteers for "martyrdom operations" against Israel and US forces in Iraq, according to the recruitment group, the Committee for the Commemoration of Martyrs of the Global Islamic Campaign.

Salman Rushdie, who received a death warrant in absentia by Iran's former leader Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini for writing *The Satanic Verses*, has also been targeted by the nascent brigade of terrorists calling itself the "Army of Martyrs of the Global Islamic Campaign."

The London-based Arabic daily *Al-Sharq al-Awsat* reported earlier this month that the "Army of Martyrs" is operated by the Iranian Revolutionary Guards (also known as the Pasdaran), and IRG's sub-agencies tasked with intelligence gathering and the planning of terrorist attacks.

The recruitment of what "Army of Martyrs" leaders say are thousands of future "martyrs," i.e., suicide attackers, racked up 10,000 registered volunteers in its first week, Mohammad Ali Samadi, a spokesman for the Committee for the Commemoration of Martyrs of the Global Islamic Campaign, told Reuters.

The calls to join the "Army of Martyrs" began at mosques after Friday prayers three weeks ago, after which registration forms were distributed by the tens of thousands at local Islamic universities to prospective male and female suicide attackers.

A senior Israeli intelligence source told *The Jerusalem Post* that complementing Iran's imminent nuclear capability are its efforts to infiltrate terrorists and weapons into the West Bank and Gaza Strip.

"There's no way to over-emphasize this danger," said the source. "Iran is involved intimately in almost every Hezbollah action."

The IRG also bankrolls Tanzim and Islamic Jihad cells all over the West Bank and Gaza Strip, said the official.

President Clinton's national security adviser, Sandy Berger, is the focus of a criminal investigation after admitting he removed highly classified terrorism documents from a secure reading room during preparations for the September 11 Commission hearings. Berger's home and office were searched earlier this year by FBI agents armed with warrants. Some drafts of a sensitive "after-action" report on the Clinton administration's handling of al-Qaeda terror threats during the December 1999 millennium celebration are still missing.

Berger and his lawyer said he knowingly removed handwritten notes he had taken from classified anti-terror documents he reviewed at the National Archives by sticking them in his jacket and pants. He also inadvertently took copies of actual classified documents in a leather portfolio, they said. "I deeply regret the sloppiness involved, but I had no intention of withholding documents from the commission, and to the contrary, to my knowledge, every document requested by the commission from the Clinton administration was produced," Berger said in a statement to the Associated Press.

When asked, Berger said he returned some of the classified documents, which he found in his office, and all of the handwritten notes he had taken from the secure room, but said he could not locate two or three copies of the highly classified millennium terror report. "In the course of reviewing over several days thousands of pages of documents on behalf of the Clinton administration in connection with requests by the Sept. 11 commission, I inadvertently took a few documents from the Archives," Berger said. "When I was informed by the Archives that there were documents missing, I immediately returned everything I had except for a few documents that I apparently had accidentally discarded," he said.

The officials said the missing documents were highly classified, and included critical assessments about the Clinton administration's handling of the millennium terror threats as well as identification of America's terror vulnerabilities at airports to seaports.



Dumb and Dumber Department Send in the Clowns

Israeli-made bullets recently purchased by the U.S. Army should be used for training only, not to fight Muslim guerrillas in Iraq and Afghanistan, U.S. lawmakers told Army generals.

Since the Army has other stockpiled ammunition, "by no means, under any circumstances, should a round [from Israel] be utilized," said Rep. Neil Abercrombie of Hawaii, the top Democrat on the House of Representatives Armed Services subcommittee with jurisdiction over land forces.

The Army contracted Israel Military Industries Ltd. in December for \$70 million in small caliber ammunition. The Israeli firm was one of only two worldwide that could meet U.S. technical specifications and delivery needs, said Brigadier Gen. Paul Izzo, the Army's program executive officer for ammunition. The other was East Alton, Illinois-

based Winchester Ammunition, which also received a \$70 million contract.

Rep. Curt Weldon of Pennsylvania, who chairs the subcommittee on tactical air and land forces, concurred with Abercrombie, explaining that although the Army should not have to worry about "political correctness," there are still "propaganda pitfalls" of using Israeli rounds in the U.S. declared war on terror.

"There's a sensitivity that I think all of us recognize," Weldon told the Army witnesses, including Maj. Gen. Buford Blount, who led the U.S. Third Infantry Division that captured Baghdad in April 2003.

Blount, now the Army's assistant deputy chief of staff, said the Army had sufficient small caliber ammunition — 5.56mm, 7.62mm and .50 caliber — to conduct current operations in Iraq, Afghanistan and elsewhere without using the Israeli bullets.


But some Israeli military officers were upset. IDF Col. Moshe Lesheme told WND, "Israel has been at the forefront of the war on terror since its founding 56 years ago. We pioneered many of the anti-terror and urban-warfare techniques that the U.S. military has no problem using in Iraq and Afghanistan. Israeli firms have created an enormous amount of military technology that enhanced the American military. And now suddenly our bullets are illegitimate?"

"It is decisions like these that feed the Palestinian propaganda machine and demean Israel," said Morton Klein, president of the Zionist Organization of America. "It makes it seem like there's a difference between terrorism against Israelis and terrorism against anyone else. And that is simply unacceptable."

Never-ending War

In his documentary *The Siege of Western Civilization*, Herb Meyer says the attacks on Western civilization by radical Islam in the past twenty-five years make the third such offensive. The first attacks came in the seventh century beginning with the fall of Jerusalem, Persia, North Africa, and Spain; this was followed hundreds of years later by the invasions of the 15th and 16th centuries.

Meyer says that, unlike Judaism and Christianity, Islam itself has never reconciled with the modern world. "Islam today is what it was back in the seventh century," he says. "Islamic countries have never separated church and state, never developed the concept of individual rights, human rights, women's rights, economic liberty, or even the rule of law."

Travesty at The Hague By Charles Krauthammer, The Washington Post

Among various principles invoked by the International Court of Justice in its highly publicized decision on Israel's security fence is this one: It is a violation of international law for Jews to be living in the Jewish guarter of Jerusalem. If this sounds absurd to you – Jews have been inhabiting the Old City of Jerusalem since it became their capital 3,000 years ago — it is. And it shows the lengths to which the United Nations and its associate institutions, including this kangaroo court, will go to condemn Israel.

The court's main business was to order Israel to tear down the security fence separating Israelis from Palestinians. The fence is only one-quarter built, and yet it has already resulted in an astonishing reduction in suicide attacks in Israel. In the past four months, two Israelis have died in suicide attacks, compared with 166 killed in the same time frame at the height of the terrorism.

But what are 164 dead Jews to this court? Israel finally finds a way to stop terrorism, and 14 eminences sitting in The Hague rule it illegal — in a 64-page opinion in which the word terrorism appears not once (except when citing Israeli claims).

Yes, the fence causes some hardship to Palestinians. Some are separated from their fields, some school children have to walk much farther to class. This is unfortunate. On any scale of human decency, however, it is far more unfortunate that 1,000 Israelis are dead from Palestinian terrorism, and thousands more horribly maimed, including Israeli schoolchildren with nails and bolts and shrapnel lodged in their brains and spines who will never be walking to school again.

From the safe distance of 2.000 miles, the court declared itself "not convinced" that the barrier Israel is building is a security necessity. It based its ruling on the claim that the fence violates Palestinian "humanitarian" rights such as "the right to work, to health, to education, and to an adequate standard of living as proclaimed in the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child."

I'm sure these conventions are lovely documents. They are also documents of absolutely no weight - how many countries would not stand condemned for failure to provide an "adequate standard of living"? - except, of course, when it comes to Israel. Then, any document at hand will do.

What makes the travesty complete is that this denial of Israel's right to defend itself because doing so might

violate "humanitarian" rights was read in open court by the chief judge representing China, whose government massacred hundreds of its own citizens demonstrating peacefully in Tiananmen Square. Not since Libya was made chairman of the Commission on Human Rights has the U.N. system put on such a shameless display of hypocrisy.

Moreover, the court had no jurisdiction to take this case. It is a court of arbitration, which requires the consent of both parties. The Israelis, knowing the deck was stacked, refused to give it. Not only did the United States declare this issue outside the boundaries of this court, so did the European Union and Russia, hardly Zionist agents.

The court went ahead nonetheless, betraying its prejudice in its very diction. For example, throughout the opinion it refers to the barrier as a "wall." In fact, over 93 percent of its length consists of fences, troughs and electronic devices to prevent terrorist infiltration. Less than one kilometer out of every 15 is wall, and this is generally in areas that Palestinian gunmen have been using to shoot directly onto Israeli highways and into villages. Sensors and troughs cannot stop bullets.

The court's long account of the history of the conflict is equally corrupt. For example: In 1947, the United Nations partitioned Palestine into two states - one Jewish, one Arab. When the British pulled out and Israel proclaimed its independence, five Arab countries responded immediately by declaring war and invading Israel with the announced intention of destroying the newborn state. How does the court render this event? "On 14 May 1948, Israel proclaimed its independence... armed conflict then broke out between Israel and a number of Arab States." Broke out? As if three years after the Holocaust and almost entirely without weapons, a tiny country of 600,000 Jews had decided to make war on five Arab states with nearly 30 million people.

Israel will rightly ignore the decision. The United States, acting honorably in a world of utter dishonor regarding Israel, will support that position. It must be noted that one of the signatories of this attempt to force Israel to tear down its most effective means of preventing the slaughter of innocent Jews was the judge from Germany. The work continues. - 28

I never thought I'd say this, but I'm deeply, mortifyingly ashamed of my parents' native land. The island nation has gone and pulled a Spain (and a France and a Germany). Philippine president Gloria Macagapal-Gloria Macagapal-Arroyohas crumbled like a fried lumpia wrapper under pressure from radical Muslim terrorists.

The Battling Bastards of Bataan have given way to the Mollycoddling Milksops of Manila. And ultimately, we — not just Filipinos, but all Americans and our allies battling Islamofascism — will pay a grisly price for this disgraceful capitulation.

An Islamic terrorist group in Iraq kidnapped a Filipino truck driver, Angelo de la Cruz. He was abducted near Fallujah while shipping fuel for an American company from Saudi Arabia to Baghdad. The sword-wielding kidnappers, calling themselves the Khaled Ibn al-Walid Brigade, threatened to execute de la Cruz unless the Philippines immediately withdrew its 51-member contingent of police officers and soldiers from the multinational force providing security in Iraq (the troops were scheduled to be sent home in August, anyway).

My prayers, of course, were with de la Cruz and his family. He is the father of eight children, an innocent man who was reportedly just trying to earn enough money for an operation to restore the eyesight of a son. It could have easily been a relative of mine in the hands of the heathens. No one can blame his family for their entreaties to President Arroyo to pull out all the stops to save him.

But Arroyo is not merely the protector of one man and one family. She is not only a parochial leader of one people. Arroyo proclaimed herself a front-line warrior in the battle against global terror. Last spring, she came to Washington, embraced President Bush, and heralded her tight relationship with the United States.

"The Philippines is one of the first countries to join this war on terror," Arroyo said. "And the reason why we did it is that we in the Philippines know what it is to suffer from the hands of terrorism. We know the pain of terrorism. And we are with you in your leadership against terrorism, wherever it may be found."

We are with you. Remember those words.

Initially, the Philippines appeared to stand firm against de la Cruz's abductors. The nation followed the courageous lead of Japan, South Korea and Bulgaria, which have all resolutely opposed the terrorists despite the abduction and murder of their countrymen. "Philippines Defiant on Iraq," one headline read. "Philippines Rejects Deadline From Iraq Kidnappers," read another.

But facing pressure from a vocal minority of isolationists, anti-American academics and Catholic church leaders, Filipino government officials buckled within hours of their original decision. Philippine deputy foreign minister Rafael Seguis announced on al-Jazeera television that "in response to your request"—"request," as if the terrorists had extended an invitation to tea —the Philippines "will withdraw its humanitarian forces as soon as possible."

"I hope the statement that I read will touch the heart of this group," Seguis pleaded further, as if he were addressing Oprah Winfrey's studio audience. He concluded pathetically: "We know that Islam is the religion of peace and mercy."

Meanwhile, militant Islamic brigades of merciless cutthroats have menaced the southern Philippine islands, collaborated with murderous al-Qaeda

and Jemaah Islamiah operatives, and will now see every overseas Filipino worker as an irresistible tool for geopolitical extortion.

Indeed, there have even been unconfirmed reports from the Philippines that its diplomats may have offered cash to the terrorists using al-Jazeera TV as an intermediary.

Some observers, including our own State Department, have given the Arroyo administration the benefit of the doubt. They believe that the wording of the nation's announcement to withdraw troops from Iraq "as soon as possible" is a deliberate ploy meant to confuse the captors and buy time. Nonsense.

The unequivocal message of the Philippines to the terrorists has come across loud and clear: We will surrender. And so has the country's message to America: We lied.

Israelis Like America

Seeing Is Believing?

People believe what they see, but often only part of the truth is shown on television:

It is not shown how for years, Palestinian terrorists have smuggled weapons from Egypt into "homes" in Rafa, through tunnels under the strategic "Philadelphia" Corridor.

Part of the problem is that people who live in peaceful countries like America or Britain cannot understand what it's like to live in a tiny country that's been hit by 113 suicide bombings during nearly four years of conflict. If that is not enough to convince the world that Israel is at war with a barbarous enemy, then perhaps the images of Palestinian militants parading the remains of the soldiers killed in Gaza would. Two Islamic Jihad terrorists are shown in a video, with a Koran in their hands and the head of an Israeli soldier lying on a table in front of them. Since Israel cannot make peace with cannibals, it only has two choices: it can appease them or fight them.

"Israel Is Poison"

The UN special envoy to Iraq, Lakhdar Brahimi, set off a storm when he lambasted Israel in the most bitter terms. "The policy of Israel is a poison in the region, and that is the feeling of everyone in the region and beyond, and I think this is a statement of fact, not an opinion," said Brahimi. He said his job of forming an Iraqi government was complicated by "the Israeli policy of domination and the suffering imposed on the Palestinians."

UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan dissociated himself from Brahimi's remarks, saying he was expressing his "personal views." Israel issued a sharp protest. "A UN official, when he speaks in public, cannot be a private person," said Israel's Deputy UN Ambassador Arye Mekel. He said such remarks "damage the image of the United Nations as an impartial organization."

UN Vs Palestinians

The UN General Assembly has passed a resolution supporting Palestinian sovereignty over all the Biblical heartland of Judea and Samaria (the so-called "West Bank"), East Jerusalem (which includes the Old City) and the Gaza Strip. The margin was decisive: 140 states voted in favor, six were opposed and there were 11 abstentions. The resolution was aimed at countering President Bush's letter of assurances in which he promised Israel that it could hold on to some Jewish settlement blocs in Judea and Samaria and that there would be no "right of return" of Palestinian refugees to the Jewish state.



On The Fence

While the recent advisory finding by the International Court of Justice that Israel's barrier in the West Bank is illegal may be cheered by the terrorists who would kill Israeli civilians, it does not change the fact that none of the arguments against the security fence has any merit.

First, Israel is not building the fence on territory that under international law can be properly called "Palestinian land." The fence is being built in disputed territories that Israel won in a defensive war in 1967 from a Jordanian occupation that was never recognized by the international community. Israel and the Palestinians both claim ownership of this land. According to Security Council Resolution 242, this dispute is to be resolved by a negotiated peace that provides Israel with secure and recognized boundaries.

Second, the fence is not a permanent political border, but a temporary security barrier. A fence can always be moved. Recently, Israel removed 12 miles of the fence to ease Palestinian daily life. And last month, Israel's Supreme Court ordered the government to reroute 20 more miles of the fence for that same purpose. In fact, the indefensible line on which many have argued the fence should run — that which existed between Israel and the Arab lands before the 1967 war — is the only line that would have nothing to do with security and everything to do with politics. A line that is genuinely based on security would include as many Jews as possible and as few Palestinians as possible within the fence. are headquartered. Why? Because Gaza is surrounded by a security fence. Even though it is not complete, the West Bank security fence has already drastically reduced the number of suicide attacks.

The obstacle to peace is not the fence, but Palestinian leaders who, unlike past Arab leaders like Anwar Sadat of Egypt and King Hussein of Jordan, have yet to abandon terrorism and the illegitimate goal of destroying Israel. Should Israel reach a compromise with a future Palestinian leadership committed to peace that requires adjustments to the fence, those changes will be made. And if that peace proves genuine and lasting, there will be no reason for a fence at all.

Instead of placing Palestinian terrorists and those who send them on trial, the United Nations-sponsored international court placed the Jewish state in the dock, on the charge that Israel is harming the Palestinians' quality of life. But saving lives is more important than preserving the quality of life. Quality of life is always amenable to improvement. Death is permanent. The Palestinians complain that their children are late to school because of the fence. But too many of our children never get to school — they are blown to pieces by terrorists who pass into Israel where there is still no fence.

In the last four years, Palestinian terrorists have attacked Israel's buses, cafes, discos, and pizza shops, murdering 1,000 of our citizens. Despite this unprecedented savagery, the court's 60-page opinion mentions terrorism only twice, and only in citations of Israel's own position on the fence. Because the court's decision makes a mockery of Israel's right to defend itself, the government of Israel will ignore it. Israel will never sacrifice Jewish life on the debased altar of "international justice."

That is precisely what Israel's security fence does. By running into less than 12 percent of the West Bank, the fence will include about 80 percent of Jews and only 1 percent of Palestinians who live within the disputed territories. The fence thus will block attempts by terrorists based in Palestinian cities to reach major Israeli population centers.

Third, despite what some have argued, fences have proven highly effective against terrorism. Of the hundreds of suicide bombings that have taken place in Israel, only one has originated from the Gaza area, where Hamas and Islamic Jihad

A majority of the Jewish public in Israel — 63.7 percent — believes the Israeli government should encourage Israeli Arabs to emigrate from Israel, according to a University of Haifa poll.

The survey, conducted by the university's National Security Study Center, also found 48.6 percent of the Israeli Jews polled said the government was too sympathetic to the Arab population. The majority of Jewish respondents, 55.3 percent, said Israeli Arabs endangered national security, while 45.3 percent said they supported revoking Israeli Arabs' right to vote and hold political office.

About one-quarter of the Jewish public said they would consider voting for an ultra-right-wing party if such a party were to run in the next elections, the survey revealed.

Arabs living in Israel have more rights than those living in any Arab country, including the right to vote and hold office, and Israel's Arabs have a higher per-capita income than Arabs in the rest of the Mideast.

Some nationalist movements and parties in Israel have been advocating the transfer of Palestinians in the West Bank and Gaza to Jordan, but Jordan's King Abdullah has always been against such moves, which could threaten his Hashemite minority rule.

"The Palestinians are no different from the rest of the Arabs in the Mideast," Benny Elon of Israel's National Union Party told WND.

"Israel's most dangerous strategy was the creation of a 'Palestinian People,' a so-called indigenous people, as if to justify the existence of a group of Arabs as worthy and rightful owners of parts of Israel," Elon said.

Palestinians speak the same dialect of Arabic that is used in Jordan and Syria, and have the same family structure, customs, dress, foods, music, and social values as most of the Arab world.

The Arabs have assiduously propagated the myths that Jerusalem is an Arab capital, that (after Mecca and Medina) Jerusalem is their third holy city and that it is intolerable to them that infidels (Jews) are in possession of it.

CAIR's Phony Petition

The killing by an Islamist group in early May of Nick Berg, an American civilian working in Iraq, was so barbarous that it put the heat even on American Islamists. In response, the Washington-based Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) launched a petition called "Not in the Name of Islam," by which it hoped to "disassociate the faith of Islam from the violent acts of a few Muslims."



On the surface, this statement "against terrorism" appears impressive: "We, the undersigned Muslims, wish to state clearly that those who commit acts of terror, murder and cruelty in the name of Islam are not only destroying innocent lives, but are also betraying the values of the faith they claim to represent.

"No injustice done to Muslims," it goes on, "can ever justify the massacre of innocent people, and no act of terror will ever serve the cause of Islam. We repudiate and dissociate ourselves from any Muslim group or individual who commits such brutal and un-Islamic acts. We refuse to allow our faith to be held hostage by the criminal actions of a tiny minority acting outside the teachings of both the Koran and the Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him."

A Koranic passage (4:135) then follows to establish that this is not just CAIR's viewpoint: "Oh you who believe, stand up firmly for justice, as witnesses to God, even if it be against yourselves, or your parents, or your kin, and whether it be against rich or poor; for God can best protect both. Do not follow any passion, lest you not be just. And if you distort or decline to do justice, verily God is well-acquainted with all that you do."

The chairman of CAIR's board, Omar Ahmad, whose idea this petition was, expressed his hope that it "will demonstrate once and for all that Muslims in America and throughout the Islamic world reject violence committed in the name of Islam."

The petition indeed won CAIR a fistful of kudos. Among others, the Associated Press, United Press International, Religion News Service, *Washington Post*, and *Philadelphia Inquirer* wrote admiringly of it. I found not a single skeptical word on the topic.

But a close look finds this petition lacking in several ways.

CAIR vaguely condemns "terror, murder and cruelty in Islam's name," but a genuine condemnation would name names and cite incidents. This is crucial because CAIR has shown, for example, that Islamist suicide bombings against Russians, Israelis and Indians do not fit its definition of terrorism.

CAIR is silent in this text about supporting counterterrorism efforts, and for good reason. It consistently opposes both the means (such as the Patriot Act, special registration for foreign visitors) and ends of counterterrorism (the arrest of Sami Al-Arian, conviction of the Buffalo Seven, seizure of Holy Land Foundation assets).

The Koranic passage CAIR quotes about "stand up firmly for justice" is not about issuing press releases or signing petitions. "Standing up for justice should mean taking real action," Stephen Schwartz, a Sufi, tells me. "In today's situation, that translates into identifying and helping arrest Muslim evildoers by driving them from the community; outlining a straight path of moderation; and making clear one's loyalty to America."

A petition is a "solemn supplication or request to a superior authority," so the obvious question arises: to whom is this CAIR "petition" addressed? Nobody — it is just an abstract statement. It might carry some weight were it addressed to Hamas, al-Qaeda or the extremists in Iraq. Addressed to no one, it amounts to just another CAIR bleating about being "against terrorism."

CAIR claims over 650,000 signatures, but following its usual unaccountable ways, it makes no names available for public inspection. This practice is particularly suspect at a time when websites such as www.petitiononline.com have made it possible to see and count each name on a petition. Until CAIR makes the 650,000 names available, this figure should not be accepted.

In conclusion, "Not in the Name of Islam" seeks to clean up Islam's image without doing anything of substance. It manages to do two things at once: impress naïve Westerners without upsetting anyone in Hamas, al-Qaeda, the Iraqi Islamist organizations, or other violent groups. In this, the petition initiative fits CAIR's well-established pattern of obfuscation and insincerity.

A fashion statement U.S. Government "Secrecy"

The Homeland Security Department's sense of fashion is endangering the lives of federal air marshals by making them conspicuous to terrorists, says the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association.

Marshals, they say, must follow a strict dress code and military grooming that is enforced by the Federal Air Marshal Service (FAMS).

According to memos obtained by *The Washington Times*, marshals must wear a suit, or a coat and tie, when flying from all cities, even traditionally casual locations such as Orlando, Florida. Their hair must be worn in a conservative style. No beards are allowed, and dress shoes are required for both men and women.

Marshals have nicknamed their neckties the "hangman's noose" because they say it allows an attacker from behind to incapacitate them.

"The bottom line is these guys are supposed to blend in a crowd on a plane, and no one should be able to pick these guys out from the rest of the people on a flight," said John Amat, spokesman for the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association (FLEOA). "There have been many instances where air marshals have been picked out by travelers; people give them the thumbs up and thank them."

The strict dress code is a response to complaints from the airline industry that marshals were inappropriately dressed in jeans and T-shirts or sweat shirts, said Dave Adams, spokesman for FAMS in the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement in the Homeland Security Department.

"We deem it appropriate when traveling on mission status to be dressed appropriately," he said.

A federal air marshal who spoke on the condition of anonymity called the dress code "ridiculous." Managers wait for marshals to deplane to check whether they are clean shaven and wearing proper attire.

"We are not asking to wear shorts and flip-flops and look like beach bums," the marshal said.

The Association of Flight Attendants (AFA) said air marshals "look like FBI or Secret Service agents straight out of central casting," and the Allied Pilots Association said changes are needed immediately to protect the officials' identities. Homeland Security spokesman Brian Doyle said each of the 21 field offices has the discretion to allow marshals to dress appropriately for the region and weather.

Mr. Adams said, "We deny those allegations [of the dress code details]" from FLEOA and AFA, whom he said are "stating inaccurate information that is sensitive security information."

"I am not going to discuss the effectiveness of the guidelines being disseminated outside, and releasing sensitive security information to the media is doing the organization a disservice," he said.

According to one memo from the air marshal office in Orlando, male officers "will wear a business suit or sport coat with dress pants and tie, or sport coat with dress pants and collared shirt. Jackets are required for male air marshals. In addition, male and female air marshals must wear leather dress shoes (as opposed to docksiders or athletic shoes).



"You will not compromise your cover simply by dressing professionally," the memo said.

One frequent flier from Florida said the marshals are easy to spot and look like "military Ken dolls."

"You can tell who they are; no one dresses up to travel anymore, and most offices are business casual," the traveler said.

A memo from the Chicago office says men must wear a business suit with a collared dress shirt, tie and dress shoes. Female marshals must wear business suits with a blouse, knit top or dress shirt and dress shoes.

"With sufficient justification and the advance approval of the respective (agent in charge), FAMS will be allowed to deviate from the above requirements. However, this will not be a routine occurrence."

The memo also said, "Anyone found not to be in compliance with this policy will be placed in a leave status. Moreover, all dress violations will be considered misconduct and followed up with quick and firm disciplinary action."

California Dreamin'

Graduating students at University of California-Irvine should be celebrating the end of a journey and the beginning of the best and most productive years of their lives. Instead, some of those young hopefuls intend to show their support for terrorism, murder and Islamist tyranny.

The Muslim Student Union (MSU) of University of California-Irvine has asked graduating Muslim students to wear green sashes bearing the word "shahada," the Arabic word for "martyrdom." The Muslim world refers to a suicide bomber who kills innocent civilians in Israel as a shahid. Pilots and their cohorts who fly airplanes into skyscrapers are also celebrated for their "martyrdom." Children in Palestinian schools are taught, "Blessed with shahada and honor, his soul returns to its Creator to live a different life, content with the rewards and honor bestowed upon it, a life of grace thanks to Allah."

In fact, the entire culture of the Islamic world appears to be built around the concept of shahada/martyrdom. Palestinians who raise their children to sacrifice themselves for Islam are richly rewarded. Indeed, children are seen as the most useful weapons against Israel.

On January 12, 2004, John Parazzo wrote in *Front Page Magazine*, "According to Sheikh Hamed Al-Bitawi, Head of the Council of Sages of Religion of Palestine, 'We in Palestine have a great love of jihad and shahada, and that makes many children compete among themselves in carrying out jihad and shahada-seeking missions.' Sheikh Ahmed Abdul Razek agrees, 'The Muslim was created to die for Allah . . . [who] has planted within our youth the love of jihad, the love of shahada. Our youth have turned into bombs; they blow themselves up among them [Israelis] day and night.'"

Justus Weiner, scholar in residence at the Jerusalem Center for Public Affairs, addressed the problem in a comprehensive study entitled "The Recruitment of Children in Current Palestinian Strategy." In it he discussed the way children relish the opportunity to become suicide bombers, the pride taken by family members of shahids, and Allah's "rewards" to them. In October 2002 *Jewish World* wrote:

"Weiner reports that another reason Palestinian parents allow and even encourage their children to get involved is the financial incentive offered to families of 'martyrs.' Thus, the Palestinian Authority furnishes a cash payment — \$2,000 per child killed and \$300 per child wounded. Saudi Arabia announced that it had pledged \$250 million as its first contribution to a billion-dollar fund aimed at supporting the families of Palestinian martyrs. "In addition, the Arab Liberation Front, a Palestinian group loyal to [former] Iraqi President Saddam Hussein, pays generous bounties to the injured and the families of the dead according to the following sliding scale: \$500 for a wound; \$1,000 for disability; \$10,000 to the family of each martyr; and \$25,000 to the family of every martyr suicide bomber — lavish sums, given the chronic unemployment and poverty of the majority of the Palestinian residents of the West Bank and Gaza Strip."

It is hard to believe that the UC-Irvine would silently endorse this culture of death at its graduation ceremony, yet to date, not a single member of its administration has spoken against the MSU's promotion of the suicide sashes. The proposed sashes don't just represent Palestinian "freedom fighters" and their crusade against Israel. They also glorify the actions of those 19 "martyrs" who brought the World Trade Center to the ground on top of American citizens. And this institution of higher learning has chosen to support pro-terrorist advocacy while this country is at war with terrorism (or rather, vice versa).

Three thousand innocent Americans died on September 11, 2001 because of Muslims seeking shahada. Thousands more Americans, Jews and Muslims around the world have died because of them. And thousands more may and probably will die as these "holy warriors" commit violent acts of terror and murder.

This isn't the first time anti-Semitism and anti-Americanism have reared their ugly heads at UC-Irvine. Many Christian and Jewish students at UC-Irvine say that they have been threatened and harassed by members of the MSU. UC-Irvine allowed the MSU to bring Amir Abdemalik Ali to its campus to provide a racist, hate-

laced presentation called "America Under Siege: The Zionist Hidden Agenda." He has made the outrageous claim that Jews staged September 11 in order to promote a universal war against Muslims. Not coincidentally, Amir also praises Hamas and Hezbollah, which have both been named terrorist organizations by the United States. Hamas also offers financial rewards to the families of "shahid."

Front Page Magazine contributor Arnold Steinberg points out that the MSU has worn green armbands before, in support of Hamas. "The MSU also has displayed posters on campus that equate the Star of David with the Swastika," he explained.

"Leaders of Hillel and other Jewish groups on campus have requested the administration record the speakers MSU and SAS [Society of Arab Students] bring to campus. The administration refused their request, even though the guests of MSU and SAS have reportedly called for an Islamic revolution in America and for supporting Hamas in its war against 'Zionists' — and Western civilization," he said.

Alkalima, UC-Irvine's Muslim student newspaper, once published a special report called "Zionism: The Forgotten Apartheid." The report glorified Hamas and Hezbollah as noble warriors against Israeli oppression. *Front Page Magazine's* David Horowitz quoted the author's intent behind the report:

"As the Zionists continue to colonize, torture and ethnically-cleanse in the name of the 'peace process' and the Americans continue to fund them, the respective staffs of *Al-Talib* (UCLA's Muslim magazine) and *Alkalima* feel it to be their basic duty to expose Zionism, its evils and its effects...Zionist-controlled world media has been purposefully distorting and misconstruing world events too long."

UC-Irvine itself has contributed to the problem, hosting Imam Muhammad al-Asi in February 2001, at the invitation of Irvine's Muslim students. He told his audience, "The Zionist-Israeli lobby, referred to by the Jews themselves as the Jewish lobby in this country, is taking the United States government and the United States people to the abyss. We have a psychosis in the Jewish community that is unable to co-exist equally and brotherly with other human beings. You can take a Jew out of the ghetto, but you cannot take the ghetto out of the Jew."

On September 9, 2001, *Al-Talib* co-sponsored a dinner at UC-Irvine to honor Imam Jamil Al-Amin, aka H. Rap Brown, former Minister of Justice for the Black Panthers. Al-Amin was on trial at the time for killing Deputy Ricky Kinchen in Alabama, and was subsequently convicted. A Black Muslim leader named Imam Musa, who has spoken at a number of antiwar rallies across the United States, was a featured guest at the dinner. He called the United States "superior in criminality and Nazism," and said, "The American criminalizer is the most skillful oppressor that the world has ever known."


This is the same university campus that once shut down the College Republicans' anti-Affirmative Action bake sale (which charged different rates for sweets based on the buyer's race and gender), because it violated the university's anti-discrimination code. Irvine's student newspaper also rejected David Horowitz's anti-reparations advertisement in December 2001. Yet the university has no qualms about permitting the MSU to endorse homicide bombers in the name of free speech.

If members of Campus Crusade for Christ suggested Christians on campus were to wear sashes calling themselves "Crusaders," the administration's backlash would be deafening. But the administration looks the other way when Muslim students support the actions of terrorists — at a time when terrorists are seeking "shahada" against American soldiers.

UC-Irvine's president and administration should condemn the pro-terrorist actions of the MSU. Irvine's silent endorsement of terrorist self-immolation must end.

At a time when students are supposed to look with wide, hopeful eyes at a bright future, the MSU wants to set "shahada" — a bloody, violent and premature death before them as their ultimate hope.

UC-Irvine should be ashamed of itself.

By an overwhelming vote of its general assembly, the Presbyterian Church USA, boasting 3 million members, is siding with Palestinian Arabs and against Israel, choosing to divest from the Jewish state as it previously did only with apartheid South Africa.

With the decision, approved in a 431-62 vote at the 216th annual general assembly of the PCUSA, the denomination is believed to be the largest organization or institution to join the divestment campaign against Israel. It is the first Christian denomination to do so.

In 2001, the combined value of the church's foundation and pension fund was estimated at \$7 billion.

Leaders of the liberal mainline Protestant church approved several other anti-Israel resolutions at their gathering in Richmond, Virginia.

The assembly set the stage for the church to divest itself from companies that receive \$1 million or more in profits per year from investments in Israel or have invested \$1 million or more in Israel. In a news release, the PCUSA liaison to the Middle East, Rev. Victor Makari, was quoted as saying: "If nothing else seems to have changed the policy of Israel toward Palestinians, we need to send a clear and strong message."

The church statement noted that "divestment is one of the strategies that U.S. churches used in the 1970s and '80s in a successful campaign to end apartheid in South Africa."

Forty Years of Failure

Violent protests against corruption and nepotism in Yasser Arafat's Palestinian Authority, and the resignation of his prime minister, Ahmed Qurei, have forced Mr. Arafat to back off from putting a relative in charge of Gaza's security forces.

Ten years after returning in triumph from exile to take charge of a newly formed interim Palestinian Authority (PA), Yasser Arafat is feeling the wrath of

his own people, who have become increasingly frustrated at the corruption, nepotism and sheer uselessness of his crumbling regime. On Monday July 19th, following a weekend of violent protests in the Gaza strip, and the resignation of Ahmed Qurei, his prime minister, Mr. Arafat was forced to reverse a decision made only two days earlier, to put one of his cousins, Musa Arafat, in charge of the strip's security forces.

The great survivor of Middle East politics, Arafat has for months been resisting pressure from the United States, Egypt, the United Nations, and other powers to merge and revamp the PA's twelve overlapping, ineffectual and mutually hostile security forces, and to put them under the control of someone acceptable to international negotiators. While Mr. Arafat has stalled, the disorder in Gaza

has intensified, as Hamas and other militant groups prepare to fill the power vacuum in the strip that will be created if Israel proceeds with its plan to pull out by the end of next year. In mid-July, four French aid workers, Gaza's police chief and another Palestinian official were abducted by gunmen and briefly held hostage by militant groups, as a protest against corruption in the PA. Mr. Qurei said this "unprecedented chaos" was the final straw, and announced he was quitting. Palestinian leaders had hoped to win increased international support for their cause as a result of this month's ruling by the UN's International Court of Justice (ICJ), that the barrier Israel is building in the West Bank is illegal and must be dismantled. The UN General Assembly is set to debate a Palestinian motion ordering Israel to comply with the court ruling. However, the violence in Gaza and the growing splits within the Palestinian leadership threaten to undermine any propaganda gains from the ICJ ruling.



Though Palestinians are angry as never before at Arafat's misrule. there seems as yet no move to topple him among the young guns jostling for power in the various factions surrounding the PA leadership. What discourages them is the thought of even worse chaos

The resignation of his second prime minister in less than a year prompted Mr. Arafat finally to unveil the long-awaited reforms of the security forces on July 17, streamlining the 12 organizations into just three. But his choice of Musa Arafat to oversee the merged forces' operations in Gaza only increased the outrage among militants in the strip, who see the younger Arafat as just another corrupt crony of the elder. On July 18, around 18 people were hurt as militants exchanged fire with the PA's forces in Gaza. That night, al-Aqsa Martyrs' Brigade, a group linked to Mr. Arafat's own Fatah party, burned down a PA security base in protest at Musa Arafat's appointment, while thousands of gunmen marched through the streets. The protests were also reported to have spread to the West Bank city of Tulkarm.

It is unclear so far whether the Palestinian leader's abrupt about-turn will persuade Mr. Qurei to withdraw his resignation—or whether it will be enough to quell the unrest in Gaza. This is likely to increase as Israel's prime minister, Ariel Sharon, pushes on with his plan to withdraw Jewish settlers and the Israeli security forces from most of the strip, as part of a "disengagement" from the Palestinians. Mr. Sharon has resorted to unilateral action since, he argues, the internationally backed Middle East peace process is going nowhere due to the PA security forces' failure to stop militants' suicide attacks on Israel. Palestinians, in turn, blame Israel's harsh security crackdowns in the occupied territories for provoking such attacks. and bloodshed if the aging figurehead of the Palestinian struggle were deposed and a bitter leadership battle ensued. Thus, for the time being at least, it looks like Arafat will cling to power and Sharon will press on with his plan for disengagement, on his own terms and in his own time—providing he can convince the doubters among Israelis themselves.



Fox News Challenged

Fox News's use of the slogan "Fair and Balanced" constitutes deceptive advertising, two political advocacy groups claimed in a petition filed with the Federal Trade Commission.

Liberal MoveOn.org and historically nonpartisan Common Cause assert that Fox News's reports are "deliberately and consistently distorted and twisted to promote the Republican Party of the US and an extreme rightwing viewpoint."

Alleging consumer fraud, the complaint calls for the FTC to order Fox News, consistently the highest-rated cable news network, to cease and desist from using the slogan.

Irena Briganti, a Fox News spokeswoman, told the Associated Press that "while this is clearly a transparent publicity stunt, we recognize all forms of free speech and wish them well."

James Kaminski, a former FTC lawyer currently practicing advertising law with Arent Fox Attorneys, sees little chance for the petition, noting that the FTC does not wade in political waters.

"Whether [Fox is] biased or not... it's a freedom of speech issue," he said.

But Chellie Pingree, president of Common Cause, said the legal actions were consistent with the First Amendment. "Fox has no obligation under the law to be fair and balanced, just not to market itself as fair and balanced," he said.

Born Again– Twice!





Banning Islam in Norway! Liberty News Forum By Carin Pettersson

Leaders of the Progress Party in the city of Kristiansand claim that Hitler's *Mein Kampf* and the Koran are one and the

same, and they want Islam banned in Norway.

"We are not the only ones demanding this ban," said Halvor Hulaas, chairperson in Kristiansand. "This is an opinion that is well established in Scandinavian countries. We are now importing people with a religion that is practiced in the same way it was practiced when it was established in year 600. The freedom we have in Norway may be taken away from us if we do not start to have some demands to these immigrants."

Karina Udnæs, deputy leader of the Progress Party's city council group in Kristiansand is pushing it even further.

"Of course, we are aware of what these mosques are used for," Hulaas said.



Judge: No More Bibles to New Canadians

The Canadian Bible Society is disappointed and strongly questioning the rationale

behind a recent decision by Senior Citizenship Judge Michel Simard, removing the Society's ability to present Bibles on request to new Canadians.

For more than fifty years, the Society has welcomed immigrants in citizenship courts, offering them copies

of the Scriptures. The right of the Society to do that was formalized in an agreement signed in 1998 with the government. At all times, it was made clear that acceptance of the Bibles was purely voluntary on the part of the recipients.

"We don't understand what prompted Judge Simard to renege on this agreement, particularly since there was no prior consultation," said Rev. Phyllis Nesbitt, National Director of the Canadian Bible Society.

In a letter to the Society, Judge Simard merely noted that Canada is a multicultural nation where freedom of religion is guaranteed under the Charter of Rights and Freedoms. His letter indicated that, notwithstanding the agreement, "allowing holy books to be made available at citizenship ceremonies detracts from this message."

"But when does excluding Bibles from citizenship courts equate with freedom of religion?" Rev. Nesbitt asked, wondering if the ruling is less about freedom of religion and more an indicator of declining spiritual fervor. She noted that "this great nation of Canada was built on a strong religious foundation." To deny "holy books" at citizenship ceremonies reinforces secular, irreligious philosophies rather than undergirding religious freedoms, she said.


